

We Believe:

* The Brazilian state Mato Grosso has 141 cities and towns - 127 of which have no Independent Baptist Church.

* Mato Grosso is the third largest state in Brazil. It is approximately the same size as Missouri, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Minnesota, and Wisconsin combined.

* In Mato Grosso, there is only one Independent Baptist Church for every 200,000 people.

* Brazil is the largest Catholic country in the world with 134 million Baptized Catholics.

* Of the 134 million who profess Catholicism only 10% actually practice their religion.

God Has Called us to Brazil

God has called us to serve Him in the Brazilian Interior. There are millions of souls in the interior regions of Brazil who have generally been overlooked by modern missionary effort. Of the 188 million who make up the population of Brazil, only 38 million live within the large cities of a million or more. 150 million Brazilians live outside of the larger cities and in its interior regions. Currently, there are only four Independent Baptist Missionaries in the entire state of Mato Grosso. That's only four missionaries reaching over 2½ million people in an area the size of Indiana, Illinois, Missouri, Iowa, Wisconsin, and Minnesota combined!

Tracy and I were raised in Christian homes and were married in the summer of 2006. During my senior year of college, God burdened our hearts for Brazil, and in May of 2007 we were able to take a two-week survey trip to Cuiaba, Brazil. It was during this trip that God confirmed in both of our hearts His call for us to serve Him in Brazil. It is our burden to see the Brazilian interior reached with the saving power of the Gospel.
